New this year:

Semester schedule.

I have moved from a quarterly to a semester schedule—2 semesters, Fall/Winter and Winter/Spring make up the school year. There are 4 payment plans—please see *Studio Policy*.

Student swap sheets.

After all students have been assigned a time slot, I will distribute a student swap sheet. That way, if you know in advance that you have to miss a particular lesson, you have the option to swap your slot with another family. (When swapping, please let me know in advance of the swap, so Susie doesn't walk in the door when I am expecting Johnny!)

Competitions.

This year students will be able to participate in local/regional competitions and recitals (other than mine) in performance and composition. If you are interested in more information, please check that box on the registration form.

Parties/Recitals.

Last year the party and recital didn't happen and I apologize—it was my first year teaching here in Florida and I was still settling in! This year, though, the piano party and recital *are* happening—the Holiday Piano Party will be at my studio (see *Calendar*), and the Annual Spring Recital will be held at the Steinway store in Boca in May (date TBD). Piano Explorer magazine.
